Class sizes	Max. 12 delegates, except advanced rescue training: max. 4 delegates, HUET-training: max 3 pax in the METS
Restrictions on courses/ methodology/ equipment	<p>Every delegate will receive at the reception an individual PPE-package containing FFP2 mask and 2 sets of disposable gloves, mini alcohol gel dispenser and a pen. Extra gloves available in all classrooms / cafeteria / ...</p> <p>The mouth mask must be worn throughout the training centre.</p> <p>Strict social distance of 1.5m</p> <p>For 1 on 1 training (working at height – advanced rescue training, mannequin will be used instead of life casualty)</p> <p>For pool / huet training, chlorine values will be adjusted to come close to max. level, see advise of CDC on pool water treatment: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/water.html</p>
Cleaning of equipment	<p>Umonium 38 - disinfectant: Used to disinfect all breathing equipment and other relevant PPE's</p> <p>External cleaning company will also use appropriate product for general cleaning.</p>
