

National guidelines - Nigeria

In order to comply with national requirements we are implementing the following further precautionary measures:

Travel	No employees or delegates must enter FalckPrimeAtlantic facilities returning from affected areas defined by Nigerian Federal Ministry of Health and Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) in two weeks upon return.
Quarantine	If any of our employees'/ delegates co-habitants, such as spouse and children, are placed in quarantine by the authorities, irrespective of the reason or background, then the relevant employee/ delegate must also be quarantined from RelyOn Nutec locations for the same period or a minimum of two weeks.
Social distancing	We are complying with the Nigeria Centre for Disease and Control (NCDC) guidance on keeping social distance of at least two metres (six feet).
Food hygiene	Frequent Handwashing/sanitizing before and after serving food. Additional sanitizers provided in the restaurant
Class sizes	We reduce the amount of delegates in classes to accommodate the two metres (six feet) social distance and temporary theoretical teaching through remote teaching.
Restrictions on courses/ methodology/ equipment	We are complying with OPITO guidance by ensuring that delegates no longer under take practical training (First Aid Practical) exercise requiring performance of rescue breath. Demonstration shall be done by instructors only following thorough hygiene procedure. All training (both theoretical and practical) are designed to accommodate at least one metre social distancing.
Cleaning of equipment	We are complying with our internal procedure on equipment cleaning and the guidelines from the manufacturer to ensure all equipment are sanitised and free of pathogens.
